We are a TEFAP (USDA) food distribution center supplied by the Anchorage Food Bank. We serve Alaskans by providing canned, frozen, and dried food items that are from the US Dept. of Agriculture. If you are struggling financially and need assistance with food, please stop by and let us serve you!

Some of the items we distribute include frozen chicken, pork, and fish. We also have canned goods such as beans, vegetables, and spaghetti sauces. We also have boxed items such as dry milk, and cereal. And also, we have bagged fruits and nuts! Our supply varies and depends on what is available from the Anchorage Food Bank.

Instructions for Food Bank process:

1. Once you arrive at Harvest Christian Fellowship (17108 Hanson Dr.) please call 907-694-9395 on the sign outside the door.
2. **If it is your first time you will need to complete a registration form.** The State of Alaska accepts self-declaration as a means of documenting eligibility. No other documentation is needed to meet TEFAP requirements. **Individuals receiving USDA food products from a Food Pantry must submit a TEFAP household application to attest that they meet the income eligibility guidelines.** The only other allowable factor of eligibility is being a resident of the State of Alaska. Signing the TEFAP household application places responsibility on the recipient for their own eligibility.
3. Our incredible staff will deliver your food to the table for you to load in your vehicle.
4. You are eligible to receive food ONCE per month.

Applicants currently receiving benefits from the following programs are automatically eligible to receive TEFAP benefits. Those programs are SNAP, TANF, SSI, CSFP, and FDPIR. The chart below shows the current income guidelines for TEFAP.
